- Sweet flesh
- Soft and juicy pulp
- Rich in various nutrients such as minerals, vitamins, calcium and iron, etc.

Weight per bunch	400g to 800g

Period of harvest	Late Aug. to end Sept.

- Seedless and easy to eat
- Crunchy with rich Muscat flavor
- Yellowish green in color
- Flesh is firm and berries do not detach from stem during transport

Weight per bunch	400g to 800g
Sugar content	17°Bx or higher
Packaging	800g, 2kg, 3.2kg, 4kg, etc.
Period of harvest	Sept. to mid-Oct.

Campbell  
Early

- Tight and close grape clusters
- Deep purple in color, covered with a beautiful bloom when ripe
- Juicy, skin somewhat thick but separates easily from the flesh
- Skin peels off easily with a gentle press

Weight per bunch	300g to 400g
Sugar content	16°Bx or higher
Packaging	2kg, 4kg, 5kg, etc.
Period of harvest	Late Aug. to Sept.
